

THE STORY BEHIND PORTER

The progressive alternative rock band PORTER from Germany has been around for quite a while and mixes the different preferences of the individual band members for metal and punk, indie and singer songwriter, hardcore and alternative into a completely unique blend that brings the sound, which is stylistically rooted in the energetic, guitar-led alternative rock of the 90s, into the present day thanks to progressive elements and a rich production.

PORTER's songs combine musical melancholy and anger with an expressive lyrical statement against any totalitarian or fascist ideas, and with their sometimes anthemic choruses become a beacon for democracy and freedom. In times when this is all too often sacrificed for the sake of security or misused by populist forces, PORTER raise the question of what kind of society we want to live in.

"Genosha", the long-awaited third album by the band from the Ruhr area, is on the home straight and marks a new start for the band with a much more metal-heavy focus. On 10 November 2023, the first single "Taxfree Hollows" was released on all popular streaming portals and clearly showed where things are heading from now on. At the same time as the single, the band released the video for "Taxfree Hollows" on the band's YouTube channel @porteralternativerock. The second single "Behind The Banlieue" followed on 22 December 2023.

The songs show the musical direction of the new Porter and the upcoming album. Powerful guitar riffs, polyphonic leads, a pumping bass and driving drums provide the musical counterpart to the urgency of the content. The new singer Raimund relaxes his charismatic melodic arcs over all of this and makes for echoing moments. PORTER, now travelling as a sextet, sound more like themselves in their 2023 incarnation than ever before. This is not least due to the fact that the entire production process, arrangements and sounds are now in the hands of the band in their own studio.



THE GENOSHA PREMISE



THE CONCEPTUAL SUPERSTRUCTURE OF THE ALBUM

On this album, PORTER relocate the current, undeniable social currents, the desire for change of some and the ossification of others, to a fictitious city called "Genosha". The paralysing lack of interest in an obviously unavoidable change towards a more thoughtful coexistence drives an initially small, then ever-growing group to stop accepting their fate as God-given and to take it into their own hands.

The name "Genosha", borrowed from the dystopian place of the same name in the Marvel comic universe - where it was used as an allegory for slavery and apartheid - stands for an imaginary world frozen in its destructive habitus in PORTER's film.

Isolated, frustrated and predominantly young people group together and set off in search of the origin, the core of everything, instead of being satisfied with superficial answers. Society appears divided. Into those who want to preserve the sometimes fatal status quo of the day before yesterday at all costs, and the others who strive for the change that is so necessary. On the visible surface, a quiet, almost inconspicuous battle breaks out, but in the medium term nobody in Genosha can escape its pull. Egoism and altruism cross swords.

In the face of a world in which totalitarian and fascist structures are becoming more and more entrenched, and for many actually seem to be viable options, PORTER explore one of the core questions of their work on "Genosha": what kind of world do we want to live in? How much freedom is enough to feel free? How much coercion leads to a life determined by others? How far do you have to go for yourself personally in order to really change something big for the better?

The first single "Taxfree Hollows" introduces the topic and the world of "Genosha" without further ado.


LINER NOTES – GENOSHA CHAPTER I

The song sets a musical scent mark of the new PORTER and shows the musical direction of the album. Powerful guitar riffs, a pumping bass and driving drums counter the urgency of the content with the musical counterpart. Above all this, the new singer Raimund relaxes his charismatic melodic arches and provides reverberating moments. PORTER, who have recently been on the road as a sextet, are making a loud comeback.

"Taxfree Hollows" - the song, like the video - is about a society that indulges in seemingly endless diplomatic debates instead of striving for real solutions, which can be quite painful. Some react with agony and apathy in the face of seemingly unsolvable problems, while others celebrate an apocalyptic ego party in order not to have to see the end coming.

In an endless time loop of ever-same actions and behaviour, a paralysing cycle is established here as normality, which seems to have no consequences whatsoever and leads nowhere except to appease each other with the most diverse means. In the end, all this works in a system that few of us have asked for, defined by simple, self-regarding minds that gain their short-term advantages on the backs of everyone.



LINER NOTES – GENOSHA CHAPTER IV

There is no reason or excuse these days to keep our mouths shut in the face of the obvious threat of fascist tendencies in society.

Don't many of us constantly ask ourselves what we would have done in the darkest times instead of our ancestors, when the fascists seized power in Germany and declared the most barbaric system imaginable to be the norm? And even more real: what will we do if it comes to that again? Will we then be the cowardly fellow travellers of the haters that such a system needs to survive - or even active perpetrators? Or will we remain upright, even if everything, really everything, is taken from us?

Sophie remained upright!

"Tout est pardonné", the fourth single by alternative rock band PORTER from the album "GENOSHA", deliberately leads the listener on the wrong track with its airy musical opening. The presumably pleasantly melancholy, almost cheerfully engaging mood of the intro is broken, countered by the lyrics that begin, the last words of the young resistance fighter Sophie Scholl, shortly before her murder by the Nazis in Hitler's Germany on 22 February 1943. Powerful words that still make you shudder today, because of her courage, her clear attitude towards an enemy as inhuman as it is overpowering, even in the face of her imminent and certain death.

This song is about courage. About remaining human in times of pure inhumanity. It is a warning in today's times, which are preparing to allow what has happened, the unimaginable, to be seen as forgettable. But it is also about the indispensable hope that can endure even in the darkest times of human existence - must endure if we all want to stand a chance against the senseless barbarism of unscrupulous dictators and their stooges. The latter are currently and blatantly dropping their masks again, in the form of influencers, parties and fact deniers. The spectrum is endless. They talk about "flyspeck" and mean 50 million deaths. They talk about remigration and mean deportation. Racism, anti-Semitism, homophobia and all varieties of chauvinism are booming again - and once again they come in the camouflage of the bourgeoisie.

Sophie Scholl believed to the end that barbarism can be overcome, that sheer evil will not outlast all time, that freedom is attainable for all.

"The time that needs you is now!" (Fjort) The question is: What will we do, what will you do?

"May they continue what we have started."




With this artistic inspiration, the basic idea for the content of the album quickly emerged: to illuminate a possible society that could both reflect our reality and illuminate possible dystopias and utopias. Like Jürgen, I am interested in the stories behind the people and so a lyrical concept based on the photographic one emerged.

Jürgen Bürgin's work has been shown in numerous solo and group exhibitions in Ahrenshoop, Berlin, Essex, Marburg, New York, Phoenix and Strasbourg, among others. He has been nominated for the Sony World Photography Award, for the Brennpunkt Award, as Urban Photographer of the Year and for the Rendez-vous Image Photobook Award.

For PORTER, this chance encounter in 2015 was a great stroke of luck and the collaboration became an integral part of the new album.
